


I can bring fidget toys, my headphones, and

When I get in, I have to put my mask on and do so for the entire show.




I may have to wait in line at the <u>Ticket</u> <u>Office</u> to pick up tickets.

Once the play begins, I will watch actors performing in the same room as me.




The story is about a business woman who is haunted by three spirits so she will learn the true spirit of Christmas.

I can count to 10 slowly, take 5 deep breaths, or use _______(name of favorite fidget toy)






When – or if – I'm ready to return to my seat, an usher can help me back into the audience.
