

The show is on NOVEMBER 19th at 12:00pm, but I can go and see my seats early that day at 11:00am.



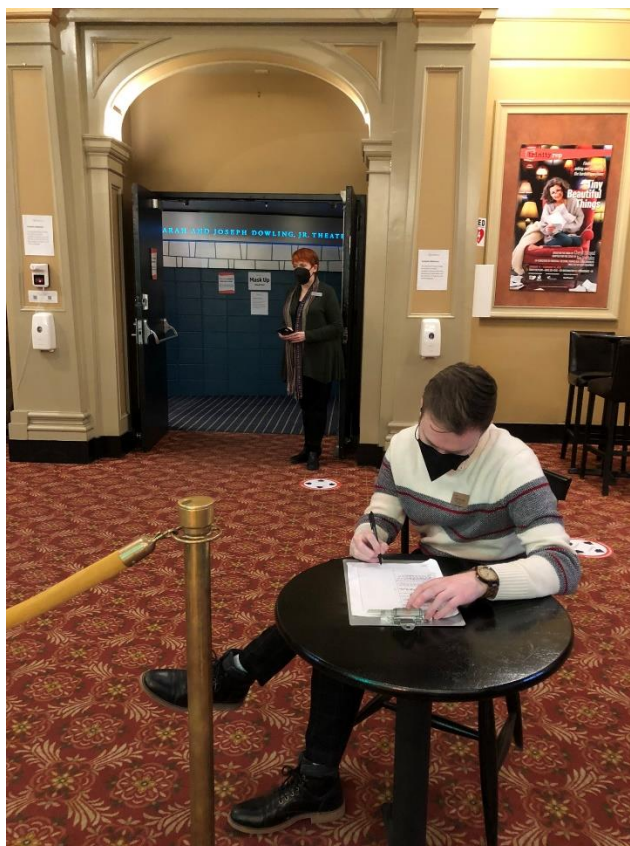

I will try to be patient and stay with _____*(name of companion)* while we wait for tickets



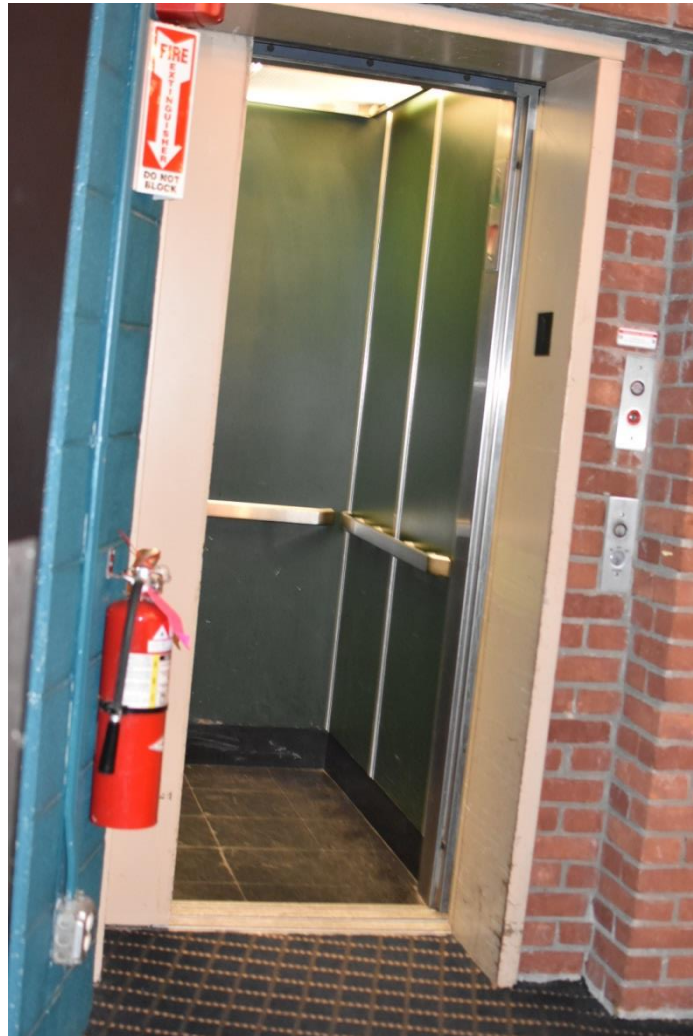
When we go into the lobby, someone with a Trinity Rep name tag will show me where to go.



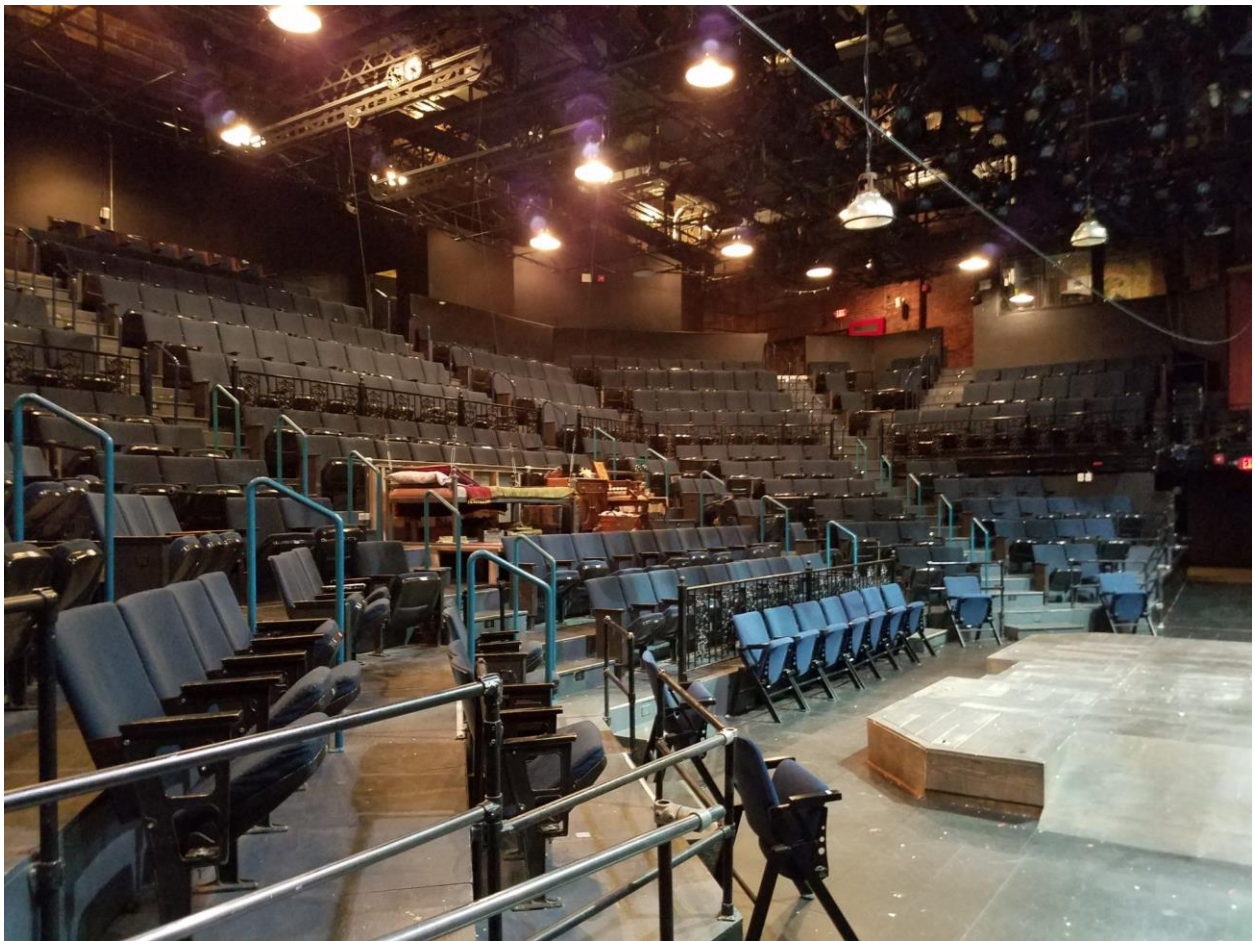
If I need to go to the bathroom or get a drink of water, I can go with _____(*name of companion*) at this time.

The story is about a business woman who is haunted by three spirits so she will learn the true spirit of Christmas.



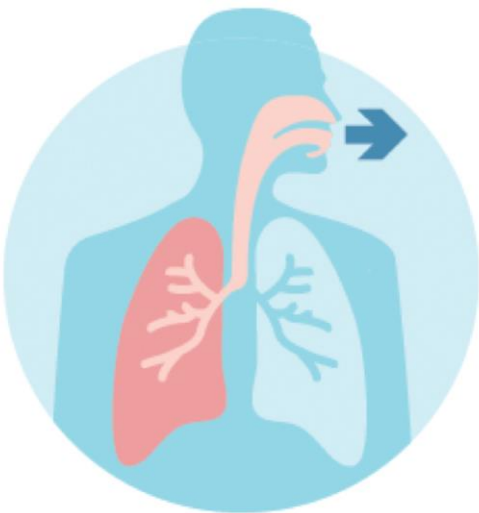
There are moments when ghosts may appear on stage but don't worry: They are only actors in costume and make up like on Halloween.
