Based on Homer's *The Iliad*, this adaptation by Lisa Peterson and Denis O'Hare is a solo show that features a lone storyteller, known only as The Poet, recounting the familiar tales of god and goddesses, wars and battles, and humanity's unshakeable attraction to violence, destruction, and chaos over the millennia. The Poet will be played by longtime resident acting member **Brian McEleney**, who will also be directing the production.

This show pairs perfectly with Trinity Rep's season production of *black odyssey* by Marcus Gardley. *black odyssey* is the tale of Ulysses Lincoln, a Gulf War veteran struggling to find his way home while unknowingly being controlled by a host of gods. *black odyssey* runs **January 3, - February 3, 2019** and is an ideal complement to *An Iliad* as they stand the test of time as both of Homer's classic epic poems.
